Breezy to Gusty winds midweek, then warmer

Wind Advisory has been issued for North and East Bay Mountains and Interior Valleys. Classic strong offshore flow event is coming, known as Diablo Winds, Wednesday afternoon into Thursday morning. We'll see a brief repeat of them over the mountains on Friday morning too. We've had strong east winds and south winds this winter. Now it's time for strong north to northeast winds. These will bring impacts to affected areas. This pattern will usher in dry air as well, which in turn will allow for the temperatures to drop overnight into the 40s, away from the immediate coast. However, daytime highs will be jumping into the 70s by Friday.

KEY POINTS

- Breezy to gusty north-northwest/northeast winds Wednesday afternoon through much of the day Thursday.
- Wind gusts will peak overnight Wednesday into Thursday morning with gusts up to 45-60 mph across higher terrain.
- Gusty winds over North and East Bay Mountains again Friday morning
- · Seasonably warm temperatures Friday into next week.




